

# Hancock Creek Elementary School 2017-2018 Basic Supply Lists

Although the school provides some materials and supplies for basic instructional activities, the optional supply items on this list will allow your child to have an enhanced educational program. ## KINDERGARTEN

- 1 Large backpack with soft sides (no wheels)
- 2 Plastic folders with 3 prongs and inside pockets (no binders)
- 4 Boxes of skinny Crayola crayons (24 pack)
- 1 Package black expo markers
- 10 Large glue sticks
- 2 Packages of skinny yellow pencils (made in USA)
- 2 Big pink eraser
- 1 Pair of Fiskars scissors
- 1 Plastic crayon box
- 2 Box of Tissues
- 1 Pair of inexpensive headphones

### BOYS:

- 1 Package Crayola broad markers
- 1 Package of Ziploc bags (gallon size)

### GIRLS:

- 1 Package colored pencils
- 1 Package of Ziploc bags (snack, sandwich or quart)

\*Please do not write your child's name on these items. These supplies will become "community supplies" in our classroom and may not be used solely by your child.



## FIRST GRADE

- 1 Backpack (no wheels)
- 10 Elmer's glue sticks (no jumbo)
- 1 Pair of Fiskars scissors
- 24 #2 pencils (American made)
- 2 Pink gum erasers (unscented)
- 4 Boxes of 24-count Crayola crayons
- 3 **Plastic pronged** folders
- 1 Wide-ruled single subject spiral notebook
- 1 Standard plastic pencil box (5" x 8")
- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 4 Expo brand dry erase markers
- 1 Pair of inexpensive headphones

### BOYS: Hand sanitizer with pump

### GIRLS: 1 box of Ziploc bags (pint, quart or gallon)

\*Please do not write your child's name or initials on any school supplies. All supplies brought in will be shared equally among all students. Please refrain from any specialty items in order to avoid confusion.

\*Please DO NOT send: Trapper Keepers, mechanical pencils, rulers, colored glue sticks, pencil sharpeners, glitter crayons, markers, toys, candy or gum.

## SECOND GRADE

- 1 Package of Pink Pearl erasers or cap erasers
- 48 #2 pencils (PLAIN - American made)
- 4 Boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 Pair of Fiskars scissors
- 3 **Plastic folders with 3 prongs** and pockets
- 6 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 Standard plastic pencil box (5" x 8")
- 2 Large box of tissues
- 2 Packages of wide ruled notebook paper
- 1 Package of Expo dry erase markers
- 3 Spiral notebooks (solid color covers - no design)
- 1 Pair of inexpensive headphones

### BOYS: Hand sanitizer with pump

### GIRLS: 1 box of Ziploc bags (pint, quart or gallon sized)

\*Other optional items (greatly appreciated): makers, extra glue sticks, extra dry erase markers

\*Please: NO large notebooks, binders or backpacks with wheels.

\*Please note that all supplies brought in will be community supplies to be shared by all of the students. Please do not put your child's name or initials on any items.

## THIRD GRADE

- 1 Box of crayons (16/24 count)
- 2 Packages of loose leaf paper (**wide ruled**)
- 3 Dozen sharpened #2 lead pencils (These will be community pencils)
- 4 **Plastic pronged** folders (with pockets) -1 red, 1 green, 1 yellow, 1 blue
- 1 Pair of scissors
- 2 Large boxes of tissues
- 3 Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 Marble composition notebooks
- 1 One inch **WHITE** three ring binder with pockets
- 6 Dry erase markers (blue or black)
- 2 Large pink erasers
- 2 Yellow highlighters
- 1 Pencil box
- 1 Pair of inexpensive headphones
- 1 Large bottle of hand sanitizer

\*Mechanical pencils, gel pens and hand held pencil sharpeners are NOT permitted.

\*Each third grader will receive a free student planner. If they lose or destroy their planner, they will be asked to purchase a new one at the cost of \$5.00.
